PUPIL OF THE MONTH— MARCH:

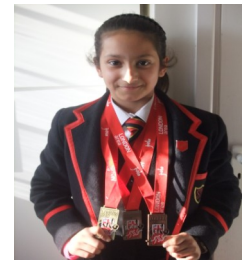
